The Literacy Education minor is open to students majoring in a field which leads to teacher certification at the early childhood, elementary, middle or secondary level. Students must be admitted to the Teacher Education program. Students from related disciplines such as Communications Science and Disorders may also be admitted. The program consists of 20 credits of required and elective courses. Students who complete the Literacy Education minor are eligible to apply for the North Dakota Reading Credential, which enables teachers to work as reading specialists at one of the following levels in ND: K-6 (Elem or Elem/ECE double majors), 5-8 (Elem & Secondary with MLE minor or MLE major), 7-12 (Generalist Credential for English, Social Studies or Science majors).

NOTE: in North Dakota there is no Early Childhood Reading Credential.

This minor meets the Title One Reading Credential requirements for North Dakota and may not meet requirements for other states.
