# Minnesota Professional Educator Licensing and Standards Board (PELSB) **Substitute Teaching Licensure Information**

To apply for short-call substitute licensure in Minnesota, candidates should hold a bachelor's degree or higher. However, there are two exceptions noted below:

Minnesota candidates that have completed student teaching through a Minnesota teacher preparation program but do not yet have a bachelor's degree may apply. The student teaching grade must be posted on transcripts.

In lieu of a bachelor's degree, a candidate may provide evidence of five years of work experience, an associate's degree, OR a professional certification from an approved certifying organization that is directly aligned to a Career and Technical (CTE) or Career Pathways licensure field.

Initial applications for MN short-call substitute teacher licensure must include:

- Completed application
- Application fee
- Fingerprint card
- Official transcripts from all colleges or universities attended
- Verification of work experience
- Conduct review statement

Minnesota's short-call substitute license is valid for three years. All licenses expire on June 30 of the expiration year and may be renewed indefinitely.
